The **Weekend Grounds Crew Supervisor** will be responsible for the following:

Leadership/Teamwork

- Supervision of the grounds crew during weekend operations
- Responsible for tournament and field related vendor relations to include maintaining park communications (both website and telephone recording) to report field conditions.

Field and Park Maintenance

- Pick up and removal of litter and debris daily
- Preparation of fields for upcoming games by setting bases, chalking baselines, and irrigating
- Maintenance of tools and equipment in clean safe manner and log all use as required

The **Weekend Grounds Crew Supervisor** should possess the following qualifications:

- Experience working and maintaining sports fields, golf courses, public parks, landscaping or other turf management venues
- Experience in all technical areas of baseball field maintenance, including the use of specialized turf equipment, mowing skills, mound and plate repair, and turf grass replacement
- Able to perform the following physical tasks: bend, squat, kneel, twist, climb flights of stairs, walk on uneven ground, lift up to 50 pounds, walk and stand for extended periods of time
- Must be able to work nontraditional hours to include evenings, weekends and holidays as needed
- Valid Missouri driver’s license is required
